[9614: Federal Grants Management for Jobs for Veterans State Grants Recipients](#), July 21-24, virtual delivery

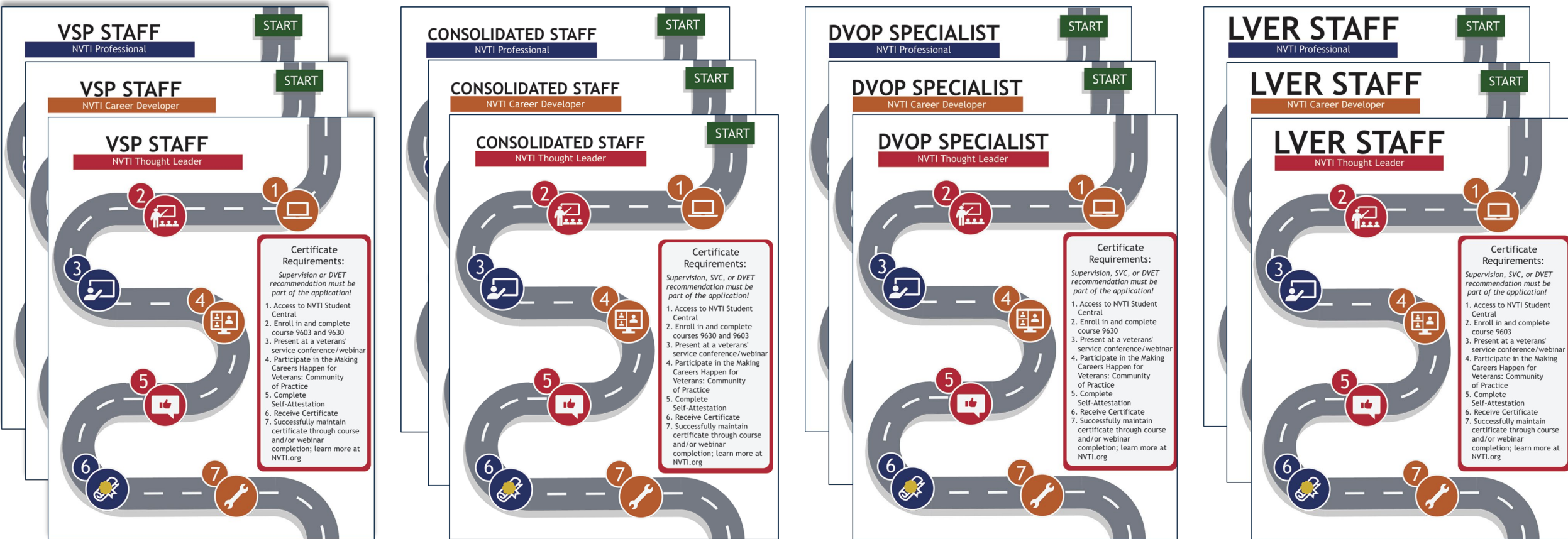

Career Roadmap Certificate Program

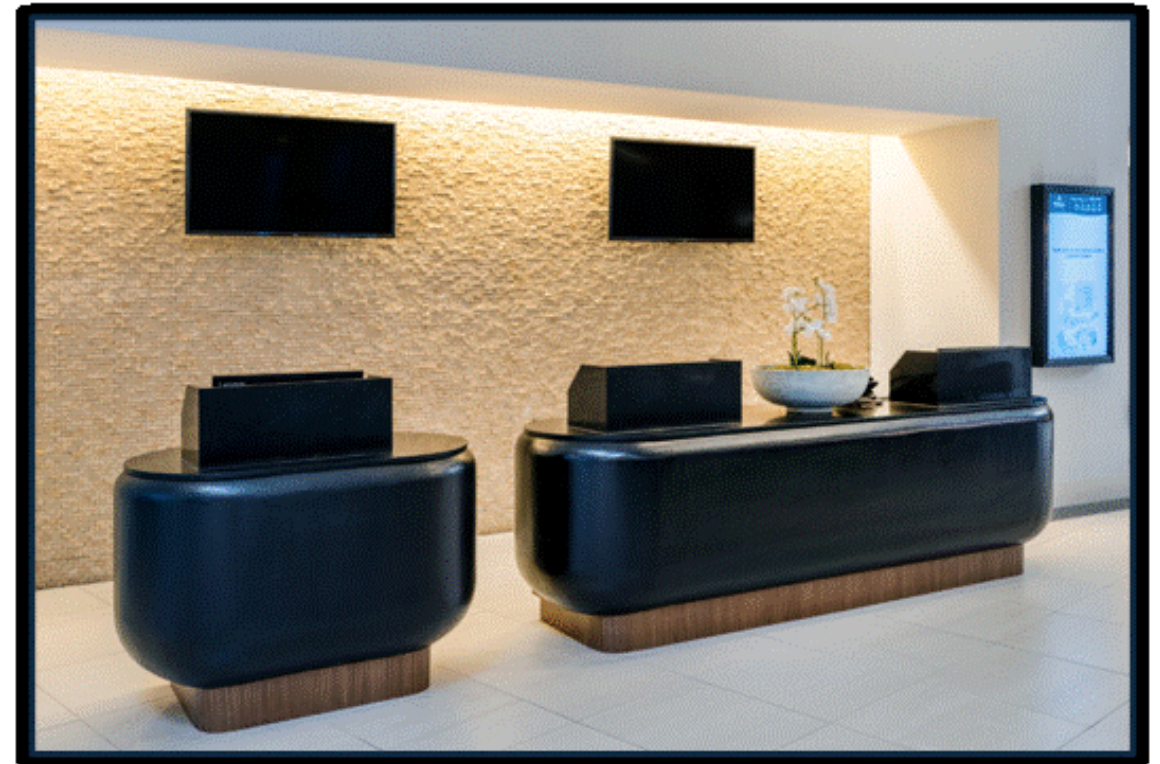

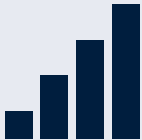

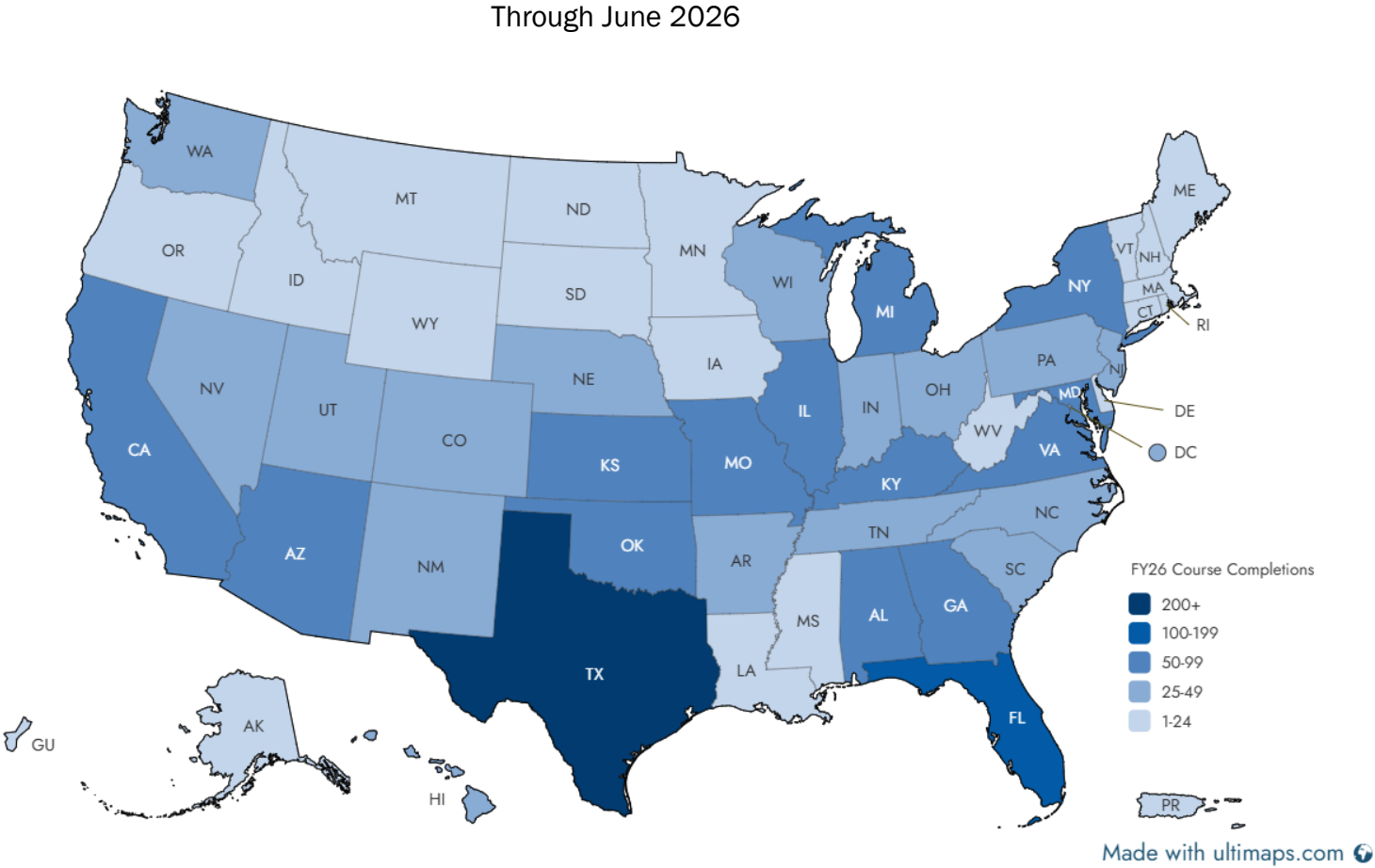
States, DC & Territories Represented

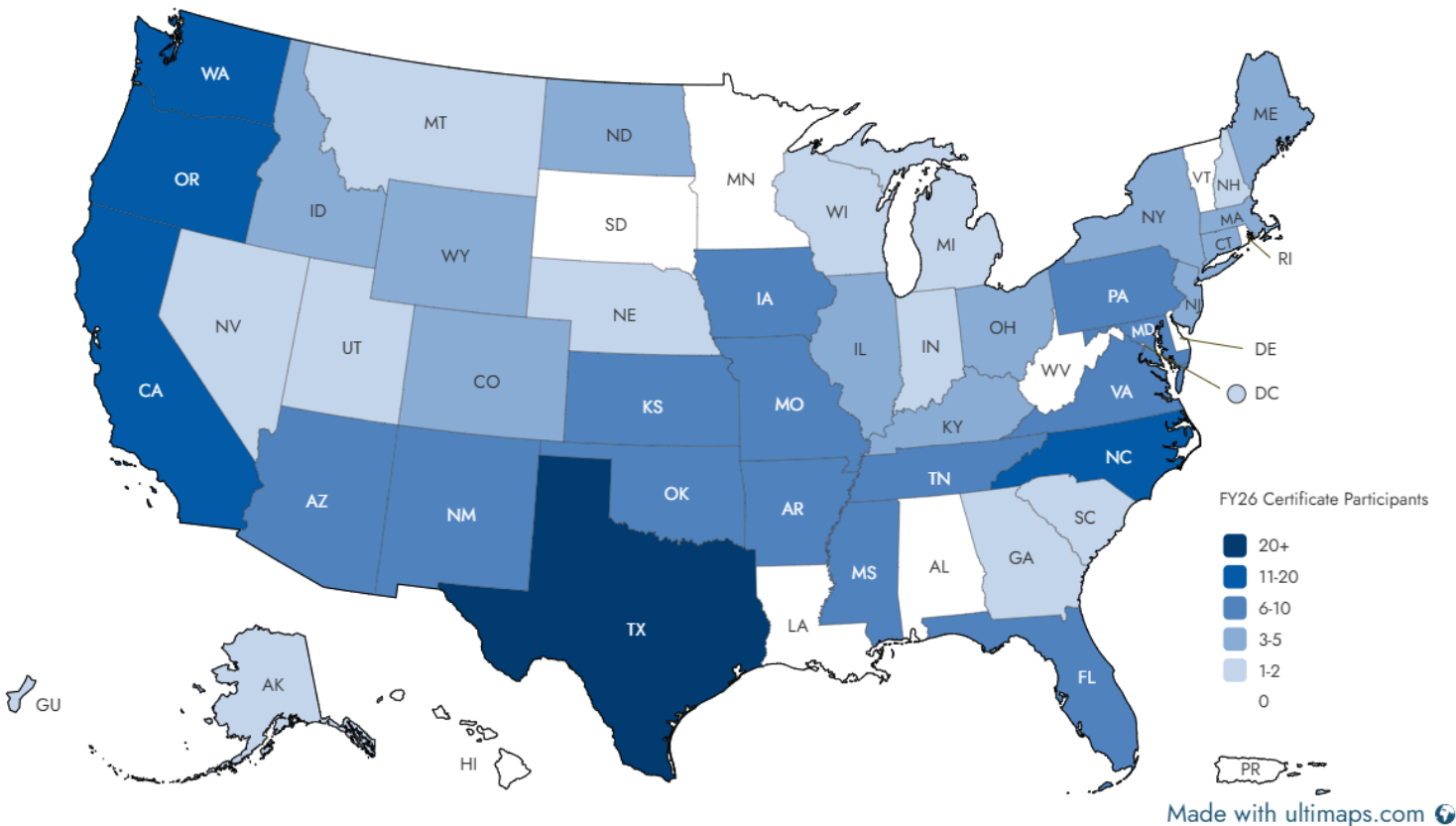
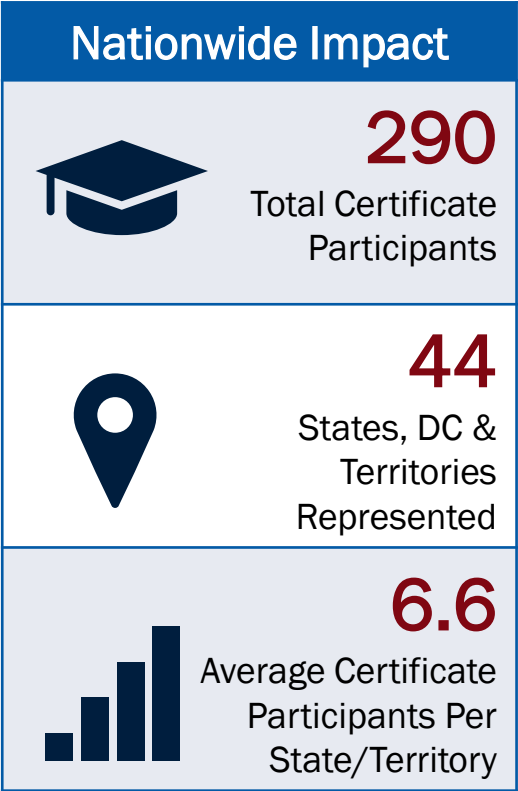

Through June 2026



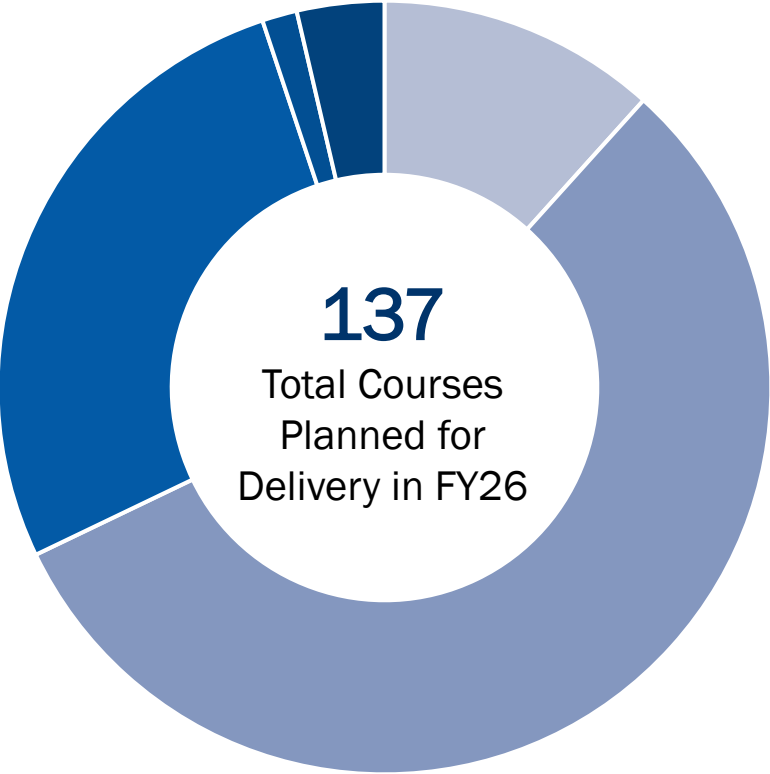

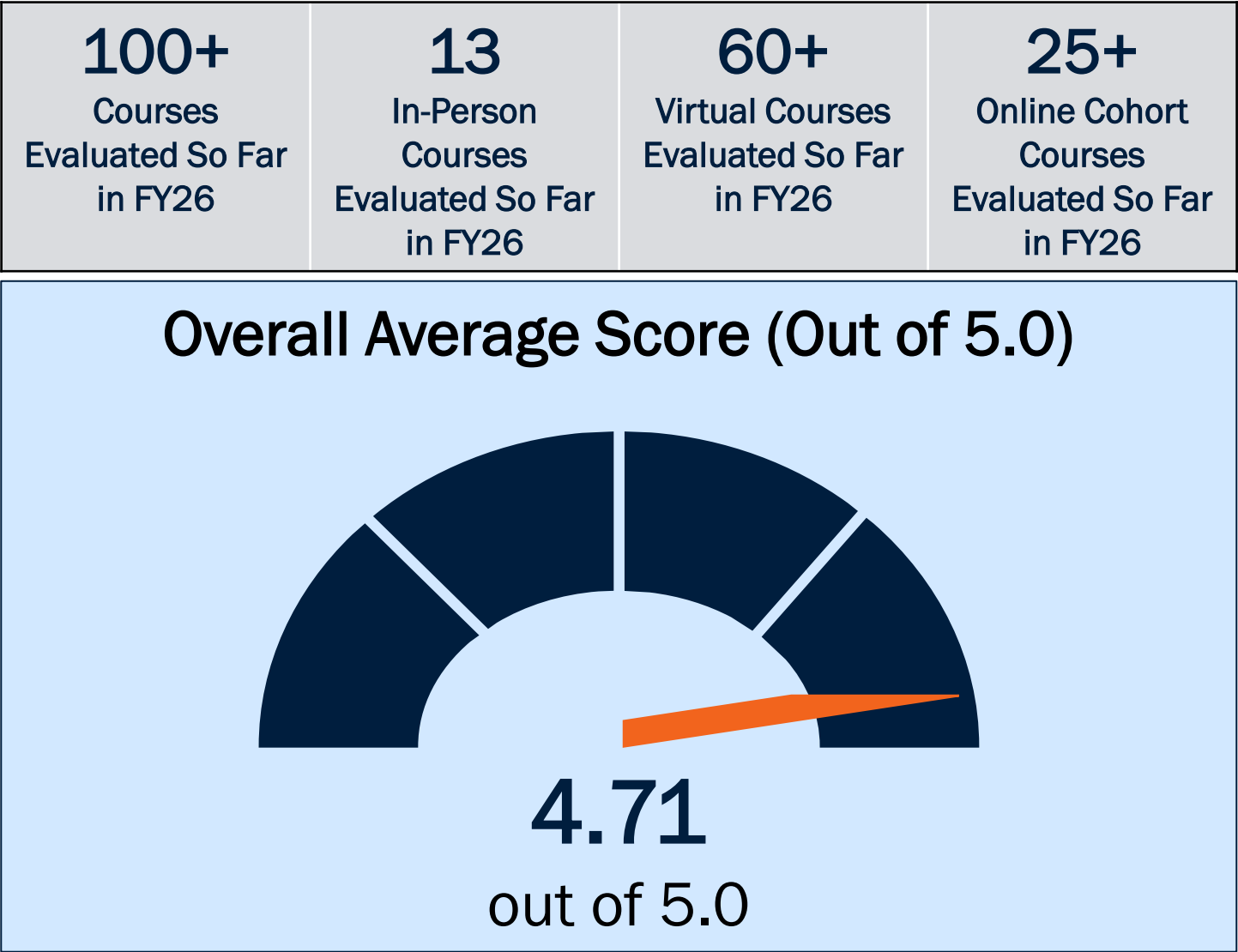
